It will be a mixed offering of online courses, hybrid (online and in-person) alongside in-person at Kings College London (KCL).


Our Programme

Our goal is to ensure interactive classes focused on key revision and exam technique with experts in their field.

By the end of the four days, students should come away with new knowledge, further exam practice, and personalised feedback on what they have achieved.

Each small group will have 5.5 hours of teaching daily, alongside a lunchbreak and 2 shorter breaks. As seen in the example content below, key theoretical concepts will be covered through interactive activities, followed by applied examples and exam practice.

Getting to Kings College London


Nearby Underground stations (train lines):

Temple (District / Circle line): next to the campus Holborn (Central line): 10 minute walk Covent Garden (Piccadilly line): 10 minute walk Charing Cross (Bakerloo /Northern): 11 minute walk

Taxis and private ride services like Uber and Bolt are also available

Commuting from Zone 2 typically takes around 30 minutes by car or the Underground, while travel from Zone 3 may take 45 minutes.

Commuting times may be longer, depending on traffic conditions


There will be a **non-refundable deposit of £200** to secure a place for the course.
